Cat-Eliminator Ti/ Carbon KTM 1290 Super Duke (2014)

Parts List

- Titanium Cat Eliminator w/ Carbon Silencer 1
- Carbon Hanger Strap 1
- 8 x 20 mm Hex Flange Bolt 1
- 8 mm Fender Washer 1
- 18mm Lambda Bung & Washer (Installed) 1

- 1) Remove the stock clamp from the rear muffler.
- 2) Remove the muffler hanger bolt from the back side of the passenger peg.
- 3) Remove the muffler from the catalytic converter.
- 4) Remove the clamp from the front of the catalytic converter. Keep this for re-installation.
- 5) Remove the catalytic converter. There are two pins at the top of the catalytic converter (see **photo 1**) which help secure the catalytic converter to the frame. You will need to slide the catalytic converter straight back in order to clear the pins and remove the converter.
- 7) Slide the carbon fiber hanger strap onto the silencer
- 8) Slide the Graves exhaust into the stock head pipe. While holding it in place, secure the carbon strap with the supplied 8 x 20 mm hex flange bolt and 8mm fender washer, leave finger tight.
- 9) Reinstall the stock clamp from the head pipe to the Graves exhaust and tighten.
- 10) Go back and tighten the 8 x 20 mm bolt on the carbon fiber hanger strap in step # 8.
- 11) Before starting your motorcycle, be sure to clean any finger prints or dirt from your exhaust system. If you don't, the heat from running your motorcycle will stain your exhaust system.

- 6) Carefully remove the stock gasket from the catalytic converter (or replace if needed.) Install the gasket onto the end of the Graves exhaust.

Apply a penetrating lubricant (i.e. WD-40 or suitable equivalent) or rubbing alcohol to a soft clean rag and wipe down your exhaust system to remove any dirt and fingerprints taking care not to scratch the exhaust system.

The heat will burn off the lubricant and create an even bluing effect.

- 12) Start the engine and check again for proper installation and clearances.
