1. Remove passenger seat and tray to access the four fender bolts.
2. Locate and disconnect the license plate light and turn signal wires.
3. Support the stock fender assembly, remove the four bolts and the stock fender assembly.
4. Remove left and right turn signals from stock assembly
5. Cut the stock license plate light connector from the stock fender assembly leaving as much of the OEM light wire as possible.
6. Install Graves tag light directly under pre-drilled hole by removing 2 sided tape and routing wires through pre-drilled hole. Make sure your mounting point clears the tag you will install later.
7. Install fender eliminator bracket to subframe using the stock fender bolts and supplied 8mm nyloc nuts. Torque bolts to factory specifications
8. Using the supplied heat shrink connectors provided in the kit you will splice the red to red and black to black wires. Apply gentle heat to connector to lock wires together.
9. Install the stock left and right turn signals into turn signal brackets using the stock turn signal hardware.
10. Route license plate light and turn signal wires through hole under fender eliminator bracket and then under the passenger seat. Reconnect signals and lights
11. Re-install passenger seat. Check for proper signal and tag light function. Install your license plate.
